Passwords: what actually keeps you safe

Long beats complex, unique beats clever, and a password manager beats memory.

Three rules cover almost everything:

1. **Longer is stronger.** A 4-word passphrase like `coral-window-baker-tuesday` beats `P@ssw0rd!` by miles.
2. **Never reuse a password across sites.** Breaches at one service are replayed against every other service within hours.
3. **Let a password manager remember them.** You only memorize one strong master passphrase; it generates and fills the rest.
